## State approves plan for Resorts around Wildlife Sanctuaries

The state government has given the go-ahead for development of tourism and hospitality services around wildlife sanctuaries and national parks. This will give a big boost to the tourism industry around the six project tiger reserves in the state.

The urban development department has issued a notification permitting construction of resorts, but made it clear that the owners can't develop the resorts if they are on forest land. However, private lands falling in agriculture category or no development zones can be developed.
