## Hoteliers switch to cardboard containers

Eatery owners are using cardboard containers to pack runny sambar and dal. They can sustain hot gravy or dal for up to an hour without leaking.

The takeaway business of more than 10,000 restaurants and hotels in city has been hit after the ban on plastics was enforced.
