

IHCL announces its fourth hotel in Chhattisgarh

IHCL Strengthens Chhattisgarh Presence with 111-Key Ginger in Nava Raipur

Indian Hotels Company (IHCL) is expanding its footprint in Chhattisgarh with the signing of a 111-key Ginger hotel in Nava Raipur, as the emerging administrative and economic centre continues to attract investment and development. The brownfield project will be developed in partnership with ECHT Ventures, further strengthening IHCL's presence in the state.

Ginger Nava Raipur will feature spacious rooms, Qmin, Ginger's signature all-day dining restaurant, along with meeting facilities and a fitness centre. Nava Raipur, one of India's prominent planned smart city developments, is emerging as a centre for technology and sustainable growth, supported by planned urban development and investment across sectors.

Suma Venkatesh, Executive Vice President – Real Estate & Development, IHCL, said the emergence of new economic and administrative centres is driving demand for branded midscale hospitality and that Ginger Nava Raipur will cater to a broad mix of travellers. Vishal Kankaria and Raja Kankaria, ECHT Ventures, said the partnership marks an important milestone for the project. With this signing, IHCL will have four hotels in Chhattisgarh, including three under development.

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
