Advancing Clean Energy Adoption

Demonstrating strong leadership in renewable energy adoption, the hotel now sources 78% of its total energy consumption from green energy, marking a significant reduction in its carbon footprint. This strategic shift reflects a focused investment in renewable solutions and operational efficiency — integrating global sustainability goals seamlessly into everyday hospitality without compromising guest comfort or premium standards.

Responsible Food and Waste Management

Sofitel Mumbai BKC has also achieved measurable impact in food sustainability, reducing 31,019 kilograms of food waste in 2025 compared to 2024. This milestone has been driven by improved forecasting, refined kitchen

practices, and conscious planning across its culinary operations — promoting mindful consumption while minimising waste.

Water Stewardship and Conservation Initiatives

Water conservation remains central to the hotel's sustainability roadmap. Through advanced water-efficient automation systems, Sofitel Mumbai BKC has significantly reduced water usage across its facilities.

The Intellipool System enables real-time monitoring of swimming pool water quality, reducing maintenance needs and filter backwash cycles — resulting in savings of approximately 120 kilolitres (KL) of water per month, while incorporating Diversey-certified eco-friendly products.

Additionally, the Intellitower System automates chemical dosing and optimises cooling tower water quality, driving further savings of around 150 KL per month. Together, these initiatives reflect a proactive and technology-driven approach to responsible water stewardship.

The third consecutive Green Key Certification forms part of a broader success story. In 2025 alone, Sofitel Mumbai BKC has earned over 20 awards across sustainability, guest experience, culinary innovation, and luxury hospitality benchmarks.
